A system located in the Northwestern Caribbean and Gulf of Mexico is expected to strengthen into a tropical storm this week and could potentially become Hurricane Helene as early as Wednesday or Thursday. Most spaghetti models show the storm hitting the Panhandle, but a few strings show the storm hitting Tampa and Cape Coral. Either way, we will likely feel the effects of the storm.

Seacrest Southwest is starting to prepare with internal communications as well as operational plans being implemented as impacts could be starting as early as Wednesday.

I will send another update Tuesday morning on developments overnight.
